Activity 1: Developing training modules on issues related to Legal services

- **Objective: Legal training on the current EU and national legal framework on immigration and asylum addressed to persons and organizations(governmental, NGOs, local) involved in the reception of migrants/asylum seekers.**

Activity 1 – Legal Services Training

The resources developed for this activity will include:

1. Existing literature on the current international, European and national legal framework. (M3-5) (AUPh, Köln, VU)
2. Creating session plans, in order to develop organized descriptions of the activities and resources to be used (M4-8) (AUPh, GCR)
 - to guide the groups of prospective trainees towards a specific learning objective
 - to detail the topics and their duration
 - to identify the methods of instruction for each topic covered
 - to check that prospective trainees have acquired the knowledge required.
3. Developing the final training material (M12) (All consortium members) (D10)

Activity 2: Developing training modules on issues related to health care services

- **Objectives:**

- **1.** This activity will develop a training module on issues related to health services/support in the country reception and/or at reception places of immigrants/refugees as well as on providing counseling and basic information to newcomers.
- **2.** The activity will also focus on training the trainers to prepare themselves on possible intervention and mediation in the community and services for the benefit of the refugees/immigrants on issues regarding health services/support.
- **3.** A final part of this activity will be the development and maintenance of a supportive network for covering needs regarding basic information on access to health services/support at the reception countries.

Activity 2: Health Care Training

The resources developed for this activity will include:

1. Existing literature on health support for refugees/immigrants (M3-5) (M4-8) (AUPh, Köln, VU)
2. Creating session plans, in order to develop organized descriptions of the activities and resources to be used to guide the groups of prospective trainees towards a specific learning objective (M4-8) (AUPh, GCR)
 - to detail the topics and their duration
 - to identify the methods of instruction for each topic covered, and the measures to be used
 - to check that prospective trainees have acquired the knowledge required.
3. Developing the final training material (M 12) (All consortium members) (D9)
4. Creation of a supportive health aid network which will provide for information material (ex. video and/or leaflet on vaccines and personal hygiene in hot-spots) (M12) (All consortium members) (D9)

Activity 3: Developing training modules on issues related to health care and legal services

- **Objective: This activity will deal more specifically with health insurance and social protection of the refugees/immigrants, specifying their relevant rights and assessing the available resources on these issues.**

Activity 3: Health Care and Legal Services Training

The resources developed for this activity will include:

1. Existing literature on health insurance/social security support for refugees/immigrants at the national level (M3-5) (all consortium members)
2. Creating session plans, in order to develop organized descriptions of the activities and resources to be used (M4-8) (AUPh, GCR)
 - to guide the groups of prospective trainees towards a specific learning objective,
 - to detail the topics and their duration
 - to identify the methods of instruction for each topic covered, and the measures to be used
 - to check that prospective trainees have acquired the knowledge required.
3. Developing the final training material (M12) (D10) (All consortium members)

Activity 4: Monitoring and evaluation of the health/legal support

- **Objectives:**

1. This activity will monitor how the respective module is implemented as well as listening to feedback from project recipients;
2. This monitoring can play an important role in meeting project goals or making midcourse changes in the project.
3. It entails evaluation of the training seminar and the action plan in close co-operation with all relevant people.

Activity 4: Monitoring and Evaluation

The resources for this activity will include:

1. Activities Monitoring

- Internal evaluation by the consortium (all consortium members)
- Focus Groups (AUPh, GCR)
- Questionnaires addressed to project recipients (Auth, GCR)

2. Activities evaluation

- Number of meetings of the focus groups (3)
- Number of questionnaires (40)
